

Sample Searches: Canadian Business & Current Affairs (CBCA)

1. You want to find articles about land claims made by native peoples in Saskatchewan.
 - Click the **Topics** tab to access this area.
 - Type *Saskatchewan* into the field and choose **Suggest Topic (enter keyword)** from options below.
 - Click the button to **Find Term**.
 - Find **Saskatchewan Canada (location) AND Native peoples** from the results list and click the **Narrow by Related Topic** link to see results.
 - Find **Land Claims** in the resulting topics list and click the **View Documents** link to see results.

2. You want to set up a monthly alert to receive links to full-text articles about *composting* when they are added to CBCA.
 - Click the **Basic** tab to access this area.
 - Type *compost** into the search field.
 - Check the box to **Limit Results to Full-text Only**.
 - Click **Search**.
 - Click **Set up Alert** on the results page.
 - Select an expiration date for the alert from the **Stop After** drop-down menu.
 - Enter a single email address in the Email Address field.
 - Click **Save**.

3. You want to find reviews of the novel *Through Black Spruce* by author Joseph Boyden.
 - Click the **Advanced** tab to access this area.
 - Type "*Through Black Spruce*" in the search field; be sure to put the title in quotation marks so that it is treated as a phrase. Click on the **More Search Options** tab beneath the Advanced Search interface if **More Search Options** are not already visible. Select **Review – Book Reviews** from the **Document Type** drop-down menu.
 - Click **Search**.

4. You want to set up an RSS feed to receive links to the articles when a new issue of *Maclean's* is added to CBCA.
 - Click the **Publications** tab to access this area.
 - Type *Maclean's* into the search field and click the button to **Find** the title.



Sample Searches: Canadian Business & Current Affairs (CBCA)

- Click the link to **Create RSS Feed** next to the title, then copy the URL of the RSS Feed from the resulting RSS feed window; paste that URL from your clipboard into the RSS feed field of your preferred RSS feed reader. You can now click the link from your RSS feed reader to retrieve new results.
