#### Two Resources in One Package

- Collection 'CO 1' from The National Archives (UK): **Privy Council and related bodies: America and West Indies, Colonial Papers** has been digitized in its entirety, to full color, archival standards. This outstanding resource contains thousands of papers that were presented to the Privy Council and the Board of Trade between 1583 and 1757, and which relate to England's governance of, and activities in, the American, Canadian, and West Indian colonies.
- **The Calendar of State Papers Colonial.** The definitive bibliographic source for information on Colonial State Papers, The Calendar covers not only CO 1, but many other collections as well.

ProQuest has created the definitive digital archive of these documents in partnership with The National Archives of the United Kingdom.

#### Covering a Wide Range of Subjects

A major resource for historians of the Americas, Britain, slavery, commerce, and the Atlantic, Colonial State Papers offers insight into a wide range of subjects, including:

- Early colonization of North America by the English
- English trade and commerce up and down the western Atlantic, from Nova Scotia to the West Indies
- Relations between settlers and Native Americans
- Introduction of slavery to North America
- English rivalries with the French and the Spanish
- Maritime history—fishing, exploration, and piracy
- Correspondence between major figures of the period—such as Humphrey Gilbert, Francis Walsingham, and Richard Grenville

#### Opening Access to Valuable Historical Materials, in Full Color

All of the documents digitized from CO 1, including a number of contemporary hand-drawn maps, tables, and letters have been reproduced as full-color, high-quality images directly from the original documents. These full color images can be examined using a dynamic viewing tool or downloaded as PDFs.

Quick Search and Advanced Search allow for differing levels of detail in queries.
